

Interestingly, Joel, Peter and Paul were Hebrews and spoke the Hebrew language. All three of them would have been speaking and writing in the Hebrew language. One important fact is that the term “the LORD” has been substituted in place of this most important name.

Did you know that it was prophesied that the false prophets and preachers would cause the Creator’s people to forget His name? “I have heard what the prophets said, that prophesy lies in my name, saying, I have dreamed, I have dreamed. How long shall this be in the heart of the prophets that prophesy lies? yea, **they are prophets of the deceit of their own heart; Which think to cause my people to forget my name** by their dreams which they tell every man to his neighbour, as **their fathers have forgotten my name for Baal**. The prophet that hath a dream, let him tell a dream; and he that hath my word, let him speak my word faithfully. What is the chaff to the wheat? saith **the LORD**. Is not my word like as a fire? saith **the LORD**; and like a hammer that breaketh the

rock in pieces? Therefore, behold, I am against the prophets, saith **the LORD**, that steal my words every one from his neighbor,” Jer. 23:25-30.

Did you know that Baal means Lord? Did you know that this prophecy in Jeremiah has been fulfilled when the interpreters took the name of the Creator out of the Scriptures replacing it with “the LORD” (Baal)?

יהוה would be transliterated into the English language as Yahweh.

Did you know that this was the Savior’s name before He was born in the flesh? There is a special meaning to each of the Hebrew characters in the Creator’s name. Each Hebrew letter is an hieroglyphic.

ה means behold.

י means nail.

ה means behold.

י means hand.

Putting it all together, it means “Behold the hand, behold the nail.” This is what the Savior told Thomas when he appeared to him in order to

prove that he had risen from the dead, “But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Yahshua came. The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Master. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe. And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: then came Yahshua, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you. Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing. And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Master and my El (God),” Jn. 20:24-28.

When Thomas saw the nail prints in His hands, He understood that Yahshua was Yahweh.

The name Yahshua itself is quite revealing. It is יהושע in the Hebrew.

י means hand.

ה means behold.
י means nail.
ש means teeth.
ע means fountain.

Once the nails were driven in His hands and He was glorified, then He became the fountain of living waters. With the teeth we consume (eat or drink).

Yahshua declared, “And he said unto me, It is done. I am Aleph and Tau, the beginning and the end. **I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely,**” Rev. 21:6.

Did you know that it is stated that there is no other name given under heaven whereby we must be saved? “Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Yahshua the Messiah of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom Elohim raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole. This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. **Neither is there salvation in any other: for**

there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved,” Acts 4:10-12.

We have revealed to you the name of salvation. The Savior’s name was Yahweh before He became a man. When born into this world, He was given the name Yahshua (Yahweh the Savior). You must call upon this name for salvation. Will you do this and be saved?

Did you know that this is the Hebrew name of the Creator? Did you know that this should be the most important name to you and everyone in the whole wide world? Did you know that the Scriptures declare that you must call upon this name for salvation? Did you know that it is stated that we must call upon this name for salvation at least twice in the New Testament by both the Apostles Peter and Paul?

Peter declared, “And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on **the name of the Lord** shall be saved,” Acts 2:21.

Peter is quoting the Prophet Joel who declared, “And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the **name of the LORD** shall be delivered,” Joel. 2:32.

Paul wrote, “For whosoever shall call upon **the name of the Lord** shall be saved,” Ro. 10:13. Again, Paul is quoting the Prophet Joel.
