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THE WORD OF YAHWEH

We previously revealed that the name Yahweh is the name of mercy, which relates to Yahshua in His capacity of establishing grace. Yahweh (יהוה/אֵלֶּיךָ/אֵלֶּיךָ/אֵלֶּיךָ [in modern, Paleo, and the more ancient Pictorial Hebrew respectively]) has to do with the hand (יָד/כַּף) revealed (הָאֵלֶּיךָ) which establishes (יָד/כַּף) grace (הָאֵלֶּיךָ). Thus, Yahweh is the pre-existent name of the Savior which declares His mercy, His grace.

Another term, or name however, that is quite revealing is the term/name “Word of Yahweh”. This is first revealed in Genesis 15, “¹After these things **the word of Yahweh** came unto Abram in a vision, saying, Fear not, Abram: I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward. ² And Abram said, **Adonai Yahweh**, what wilt thou give me, seeing I go childless, and the steward of my house is this Eliezer of Damascus? ³And Abram said, Behold, to me thou hast given no seed: and, lo, one born in my house is mine heir. ⁴And, behold, **the word of Yahweh** came unto him, saying, This shall not be thine heir; but he that shall come forth out of thine own bowels shall be thine heir. ⁵And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be. ⁶And he believed in **Yahweh**; and he counted it to him for righteousness. ⁷And he said unto him, I am **Yahweh** that brought thee out of Ur of the Chaldees, to give thee this land to inherit it. ⁸And he said, **Adonai Yahweh**, whereby shall I know that I shall inherit it? ⁹And he said unto him, Take me an heifer of three years old, and a she goat of three years old, and a ram of three years old, and a turtledove, and a young pigeon. ¹⁰And he took unto him all these, and divided them in the midst, and laid each piece one against another: but the birds divided he not. ¹¹And when the fowls came down upon the carcasses, Abram drove them away. ¹²And when the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram;

and, lo, an horror of great darkness fell upon him. ¹³And he said unto Abram, Know of a surety that thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them four hundred years; ¹⁴And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge: and afterward shall they come out with great substance. ¹⁵And thou shalt go to thy fathers in peace; thou shalt be buried in a good old age. ¹⁶But in the fourth generation they shall come hither again: for the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet full. ¹⁷And it came to pass, that, when the sun went down, and it was dark, behold a smoking furnace, and a burning lamp that passed between those pieces. ¹⁸In the same day **Yahweh** made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates: ¹⁹The Kenites, and the Kenizzites, and the Kadmonites, ²⁰And the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Rephaims, ²¹And the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Girgashites, and the Jebusites,” vv. 1-21.

In these verses, we have “the Word of Yahweh” also addressed as “Adonai (Sovereign, Master) Yahweh” as well as “Yahweh.”

It is revealed in the book of Psalms, “¹Rejoice in **Yahweh**, O ye righteous: for praise is comely for the upright. ² Praise **Yahweh** with harp: sing unto him with the psaltery and an instrument of ten strings. ³Sing unto him a new song; play skilfully with a loud noise. ⁴For **the word of Yahweh** is right; and all his works are done in truth. ⁵He loveth righteousness and judgment: the earth is full of the goodness of Yahweh. ⁶ **By the word of Yahweh were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.** ⁷He gathereth the waters of the sea together as an heap: he layeth up the depth in storehouses. ⁸Let all the earth fear **Yahweh**: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him. ⁹For **he spake, and it was done; he commanded, and it stood fast,**” 33:1-9.



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Yahweh made all things by the power of His word, and as He commanded everything stood fast!

JOHN'S WITNESS

The Apostle John reveals, “¹In the beginning was **the Word**, and **the Word** was with Yahweh, and **the Word was Yahweh**. (Note: *I’m translating the traditional word “God” or “Elohim” as Yahweh, because the Torah, Prophets, and Psalms reveal that such is the case.*) ²The same was in the beginning with Yahweh. ³All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made. In him was life; and the life was the light of men. ⁵And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not. ⁶There was a man sent from Yahweh, whose name was John. ⁷The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe. ⁸He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light. ⁹That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world. ¹⁰**He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.** ¹¹He came unto his own, and his own received him not. ¹²But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of Elohim, even **to them that believe on his name:** ¹³Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of Elohim. ¹⁴And **the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us,** (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) **full of grace and truth,**” Jn. 1:1-14.

Here is John revealing to us that Yahshua is the Word of Yahweh! He declares that He is the Word that created everything! Nothing came into existence without Him!

Furthermore, He is also revealed to be “the Word of Yahweh” in the book of Revelation, “¹¹And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. ¹²His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. ¹³And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and

his name is called **The Word of Yahweh.** ¹⁴And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. ¹⁵And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty Yahweh. ¹⁶And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND SOVEREIGN OF SOVEREIGNS,” Rev. 19:11-16.

This is Yahshua the Messiah returning in His power, honor, and glory! His name is called “The Word of Yahweh!”

YAHSHUA'S WITNESS

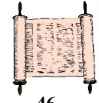
Yahshua proclaimed that He is the “door”, “¹Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that entereth not by **the door** into the sheepfold, but climbeth up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber. ²But he that entereth in by **the door** is the shepherd of the sheep. ³To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out. ⁴And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice. ⁵And a stranger will they not follow, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers. ⁶This parable spake Yahshua unto them: but they understood not what things they were which he spake unto them. ⁷Then said Yahshua unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **I am the door** of the sheep. ⁸All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them. ⁹**I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved,** and shall go in and out, and find pasture. ¹⁰The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. ¹¹I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep,” Jn. 10:1-9.

He also told the disciples, “**I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me,**” Jn. 14:6.

The only way to the Father is through



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Yahshua the Messiah. There is no other way!
He is the door and the way!

Paul writes, “For through him we both (Jew and Gentile) have access by one Spirit unto the Father,” Eph. 2:18.

The book of Hebrews states, “¹⁹Having therefore, brethren, boldness to **enter into the holiest by the blood of Yahshua**, ²⁰By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; ²¹And having an high priest over the house of Yahweh; ²² Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water,” Heb. 10:19-22.

WITNESS OF THE HEBREW ALPHABET

What we now need to do is take a look at the Pictorial Hebrew for “WORD OF YAHWEH.” This will verify what has been said.

The Hebrew word for “Word” is *dabar* (דָּבָר). (Remember that Hebrew reads from right to left. Notice the first letter which is a *dalet* (ד). It is the picture of a DOOR!

The next letter is a *beit* (ב) which is the picture of a tent, house, temple, family!

The last letter is a *resh* (ר), which is the picture of a head, and that is exactly what the word means “head!”

Therefore, the Hebrew word for “word” (*dabar*/דָּבָר) has to do with the door (ד) to the house’s (ב) head (ר)!

The head (ר) of the house (ב) is the Father Yahweh. Yahshua is the door (ד) to His throne.

The Scriptures reveal that no one has seen the Father at any time, “⁴⁴No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day. ⁴⁵It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of Yahweh. Every man therefore that hath heard, and

hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me. ⁴⁶**Not that any man hath seen the Father, save he which is of Yahweh, he hath seen the Father,**” Jn. 6:44-46.

“No man hath seen Yahweh at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him,” Jn. 1:18.

“³¹If I bear witness of myself, my witness is not true. ³²There is another that beareth witness of me; and I know that the witness which he witnesseth of me is true. ³³Ye sent unto John, and he bare witness unto the truth. ³⁴But I receive not testimony from man: but these things I say, that ye might be saved. ³⁵He was a burning and a shining light: and ye were willing for a season to rejoice in his light. ³⁶But I have greater witness than that of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me. ³⁷And **the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape.** ³⁸And ye have not his word abiding in you: for whom he hath sent, him ye believe not. ³⁹Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me. ⁴⁰And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life,” Jn. 5:32-40.

CONCLUSION

Yahshua is the “Word of Yahweh.” This term looks like this in Hebrew בְּדִבְרֵי יְהוָה / דָּבָר - אֱלֹהִים (Modern, Paleo, and Pictorial Hebrew respectively). It is pronounced Dabar-Yahweh!

Scripture reveals that He is the One Who created all things. He is the One Who has always dealt with mankind, specifically and especially the patriarchs and Israel. No one will ever be able to see the Father until the day that they are resurrected incorruptible and immortal. However, we now have the way open to pray to Him in Yahshua’s name, as He instructed. HalleluYah!!!!
